**3. Public Comment:**

Chief Klevmyr introduced Christian Avila as the new OES Business Manager.

**4. Agenda Items:**

#### **4.1 Presentation by First Due**

A very descriptive presentation was given demonstrating that each fire department will be able to build their dashboard and layer it accordingly. First Due covers everything pertaining the fire industry including fire prevention, administration including shift set up, billing, apparatus, station response and personnel on scene. There is the ability to use AI to dictate and it will pull it together to create reports. They will set up multiple days for training and assist with any set up/justifications needed.

#### **4.2 Consideration and approval of Funding to transition to First Due RMS due to the Zoll contract cancellation**

A Power Point presentation was presented by Chief Parnell and Chad Homme, a copy is attached.

After the presentation Chief Parnell asked if he could get a Motion to start the transition to First Due. Chief Klevmyr moved to start the process of the transition; Chief Bowen seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed, motion carries.

#### **4.3 Discussion of Central Square Contract and Contract between Stanislaus County and the Fire Districts**

Chief Klevmyr gave a brief overview stating SR911 was paid by commission and that it is governed by a JPA with the county and city; there is a board consisting of four representatives, two from the County and two from the City.

There is a user forum held once a month and he suggested that an agency representative should attend for more information.

CAD/CDAC was voted by the board and unanimously they voted for Central Square. The City of Modesto has signed a contract, but the County has not because they are waiting to see if the Sheriff will be using ORACLE. There is the option of the County signing, and the Sheriff could sign later. Of course, if the Sheriff stays the cost will be the same but higher if they don't. He stated that a question is if the county pays or the individual departments.

There are many things to consider with this as far as costs, who pays, etc. It was suggested that more information including the expense is gathered, and it be presented at an upcoming RFA meeting.

There will be a presentation on Tuesday, February 4, 2025, for the reported times for SR911 transfer times.
